

GETTYSBURG COUNTRY DAY CAMP
CAMPER EXPECTATIONS


1. Campers are to respect the counselors, Director, special visitors and other Granite Hill staff members at all times.
2. Campers are expected to respect the rights of others as well as Granite Hill property.
3. Campers are to adhere to all expectations and regulations established by Gettysburg Country Day Camp Director and counselors. The Camp Director and/or counselors determine consequences unless regulation falls under sections II found below.
4. Campers must wear clothes and shoes AT ALL TIMES unless they are inside the fenced pool area.
5. Campers are expected to vote and participate in all camp activities scheduled by the Director and counselors.
6. Campers are expected to conduct themselves in a respectful, courteous and orderly manner at all times, i.e., not to be a source of disruption or be involved in any form of fighting during camp.
7. The use of unbecoming or vulgar/offensive, inappropriate language or pictures WILL NOT be tolerated at camp whether it is verbal or written. Suspension or expulsion from camp will result from such behavior.
8. Campers are expected to remain with counselors and Director at all times. Under no circumstances do campers have permission to walk freely around the property.
9. Campers are expected to participate in activities without exhibiting rough and aggressive behavior. Campers may be omitted from participating in activities and swimming for such behavior.
10. Lunch time behavior should reflect good manners, including wearing cover-ups over bathing suits or dry clothes, sitting at a table, speaking in a quiet voice, discarding trash in a trashcan and putting lunch box/cooler back in bin.
11. Granite Hill and its staff are not responsible for any valuable objects that are brought to camp. Furthermore, Campers are not permitted to bring electronics to camp, i.e., Gameboys, Gamegears, iPods, etc.
12. Campers must walk at all times in the fenced pool area. Campers should not splash, dunk, push, or display any other rough or aggressive behavior in the pool and/or fenced pool area.
13. Campers are not permitted to swim in the deep end of the pool, designated by a rope, unless they have passed the swim test administered by the camp lifeguard(s).

I. Regulations administered by counselors or Director:

- a. Campers must be polite and respectful to peers and adults
- b. Campers must keep their belongings in their bin and must cleanup after themselves at lunch and snack times
- c. Campers must participate in scheduled activities
- d. Campers must follow all pool rules
- e. Campers must play games fairly and always demonstrate sportsmanship

II. Regulations that could require a conference between parent and Director and/or Upper Management. Violation of any of the following could result in suspension or expulsion from Day Camp.

- a. Campers must not use obscene or vulgar language
- b. Campers must not possess or distribute indecent literature
- c. Campers may not leave Granite Hill property during camp hours without permission
- d. Campers must not talk or act in a disrespectful way to any peer or adult
- e. Campers must not threaten, harass or physically harm another person
- f. Campers must not carry any dangerous objects
- g. Campers must not destroy or damage Granite Hill property
- h. Campers must not use, take, sell or give away drugs or medication on Granite Hill property
- i. Campers must not drink, sell or give away any alcoholic beverages on Granite Hill property
- j. Campers must not repeatedly disobey any of the regulations listed above
